To start your "Singin' On the Streets" event, you will need to:

1. **F**ind friends or colleagues in your school, workplace, local parish or support group who are interested in taking part.
2. **P**ick a date and time between the 10th and 17th of December (inclusive).
3. **P**ick a location with enough space and publicity for your group of carol singers.
4. **C**ontact your local Police Station and Local Council for permission. For example, you may need to apply for a licence but permissions vary from area to area. Don't forget to make sure that your chosen venue is happy for you to sing there!
5. **D**ecide which carols you want to sing and whether you want any musical accompaniment. Make sure everyone has all the words and even have a practice session.
