

# Good news from the Tax Man for Street Child Africa....



Following the 2000 Budget, Street Child Africa can reclaim all the income tax paid on all donations from UK taxpayers. This applies to one-off donations as well as regular donations, and means that for every £1 you donate, the Tax Man adds 28p to Street Child Africa.
